Course Description

SANDEE is organizing a two-week training course on Research Methods in Environmental and Resource Economics during January 14-24, 2013 in Dhulikhel, Nepal. This course is a practical course designed for current SANDEE researchers who are working at different stages of their research projects.

The course seeks to provide practical knowledge and hands-on training on sampling, survey instruments, data collection/management, data analysis and manuscript development. Participants will be trained on the use of statistical software such as STATA and data management software such as CSPro. This will be a personalized training and participants will work on various aspects of their own projects including editing manuscripts and revising their questionnaires.

Modules

This course is divided into following modules –

- 1. Survey design and sampling
- 2. Survey implementation
- 3. Data management
- 4. Literature review, manuscript development and editing
- 5. Data analysis and basic econometrics
- **6.** Group work and presentations

Participants

Some 24 participants from South Asia will attend the course. Throughout the workshop, participants are expected to participate actively and may be required to present their research, depending on the status of their research project. New researchers will present their research ideas and study design.
