

Status of REDD+ Preparedness

- REDD+ strategy and or Action Plan
 - Analyses of drivers of deforestation & forest degradation
 - Valuation of Forest Ecosystem Services starting soon
 - > Potential REDD+ actions piloted in 5 CFs

- REDD+ Safeguards
 - ➤ Roadmap document for Bhutan's approach to REDD+ Safeguards

Status of REDD+ Preparedness

NFMS

- Land use and land cover map 2015
- ➤ Participatory monitoring framework for CFs being developed

• FREL

- ➤NFI completed in all 20 districts
- ➤ Data analysis
- Carbon sample collection (for understory and soil carbon) also completed.
- >QAQC & biomass equation development on-going
- Forest cover mapping 2016 under way

Status of REDD+ Preparedness

- REDD+ pilots
 - > REDD+ PES pilot site
 - Piloting Heritage Forests in 20 sites in all 20 districts
- Preparatory works on-going for development of REDD+ National Strategy, FREL, MRV, Safeguards, GRM, Benefit sharing & fund mobilization
- Capacity building, awareness raising and sensitization
- Institutional and management arrangement for REDD+ implementation
