



Dr. Pema Gyamtsho is the Director General of ICIMOD. He is the first Director General from the region that ICIMOD serves since its establishment in 1983. He served the Royal Government of Bhutan for over three decades in natural resources management and planning; rural development; agriculture; forestry; livestock and food production; rangeland management; livestock development; participatory approaches; research and extension institutional building; climate change and environmental protection;

biodiversity conservation; and organic farming. He previously led ICIMOD's efforts in policy and partnerships and regional rangeland management work.

In his previous role as Minister of Agriculture and Forests, he was involved in spearheading Bhutan's rural development programme and in advancing its exemplary environmental agenda, including Bhutan's commitment to remain carbon neutral for all times to come.

Dr. Gyamtsho holds a PhD in Natural Sciences from the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich. He has also been conferred an Honorary Doctorate by TERI School of Advanced Studies, in recognition of his distinguished contributions to sustainability, the environment, and public policy.
